OUR COMMUNITY

The school is supported by its local community and we often visit local groups, bringing different generations together, including regular trips to Brook House in the Village. Friends of Husbands Bosworth (our PTA) run a variety of events to raise funds for the school, while our governors and volunteers support the school in its continued development.

We use the local facilities such as the village hall and tennis courts to help with our curriculum offer and our strong link with All Saints Church means we take part in services and events year round. Through our Farm School initiative, we have good links with Leicestershire & Rutland Young Farmers and our local farming neighbours, who we regularly visit to provide real-life experiences to our children.

OUR SCHOOL



Our school is based on two sites. The younger children are based in the 'Field Rooms', which gives them access to the large outside area as well as having modern classrooms and facilities.

Our original school building still retains much of its Victorian charm - but don't worry the heating, toilets and facilities are 21st century!

Both sites have access to the internet and banks of laptops to use to support the curriculum.

WIDER CURRICULUM OPPORTUNITIES

We offer a range of after school activities including sports clubs delivered by our Sports Coach, Art Club with a local artist and a Choir which is run by a professional musician.

All children in KS2 have the opportunity to learn to play a musical instrument such as brass or violin.

SCHOOL MEALS

School meals are provided by our caterers Miquil and delivered daily. Children can choose from hot or cold options via the seasonal menu. Children are also welcome to bring a packed lunch if they prefer. (Water and a healthy snack from home are also permitted.)

Free school meals are offered to all children in Foundation Stage and Years 1 and 2 under the Government's Universal Infant Free School Meals programme. Children who are entitled to Pupil Premium will also receive a free school lunch.
